C-Leg 4

In the medical record describe patient's daily functional activities (home, vocational, therapeutic, exercise, recreational, etc.) in K-Level terms:

If K2 is allowed by coverage policy:

Additional features provided by X3 (C-Leg/C-Leg 4 & Genium do not have)

- Has a need for running longer distances
- Has activities that require a Mute Mode (no vibration or alarm)
- Has activities in or around water
