- ➔ Available for disabled adults and a family with a disabled child

Provides funding for:

- ➔ Wheelchairs, Walkers, Scooters, Seating
- ➔ Orthotics, Prosthetics

- ➔ Access Equipment (ramps, lifts)
- ➔ Bathroom Aids

### Muscular Dystrophy, Safeway Mobility Grant Ontario-Nunavut

Must be registered with Muscular Dystrophy Canada

Product cannot already be purchased

Funding is available for:

- ➔ Mobility aids: wheelchairs, walkers and scooters
- ➔ Seating and position aids: specialty cushions, power tilt and lift chairs
- ➔ Orthopaedic devices: leg braces, AFOs and orthopaedic splinting
- ➔ Access equipment: stair glides, porch lifts and ramps
- ➔ Bathing devices

### Nunavut Health Insurance [Provincial] Extended Health Benefits (EHB)

---

For Nunavut residents who need additional health care services not covered by the Nunavut Health Care Plan and those not covered or fully covered by their third-party insurance like Health Canada's Non-Insured Health Benefits (NIHB), or employer-provided health plans.
