Instructions for sending scanned files

Note: For some extreme shapes or invaginations it may be best to capture with a standard plaster cast. (See Casting instructions on the back of the order form)

1. Scan limb (For limbs with soft tissue it may be beneficial to support with a sheath or sock)

Scan below knee limbs from at least 8 inches (20 cm) above MPT to distal end.

- a. This should be done in 10 degrees knee flexion. For limbs shorter than 4 inches (10 cm) a larger flexion angle of 20 degrees is best.
- 2. Do not modify or apply reductions to the scan as we want to utilize the true limb shape.
- 3. Save scanned file as one of the following file types:
 - a. Preferred: (.stl) (.obj) (Tracer .bk or .ak)
 - b. (.aop) (.fsn)
- 4. Fill out the Unique Custom Liner order form and indicate that this order is for a scanned and e-mailed file. Attach order form as a scanned document to the e-mail or fax to Otto Bock Salt Lake City.
